Performance Measurement

Raynesway Construction is committed to the principles of Continuous Improvement and the delivery of Best Value for our Clients. To improve performance, it is of course necessary to measure it. We do this formally in two ways.

In the first place we invite our Client, or a representative, to take part in a **Post-Contract Performance Appraisal** at the end of each project. These are informal interviews with a senior member of our staff, who was not directly involved in the project. We ask for a mark to be given against eleven measures of our performance and take careful note of all comments offered.

Next, we have developed a series of **Key Performance Indicators** benchmarks based upon the standards published by DETR's Construction Best Practice Programme. These are calculated twice each year and enable us to benchmark our performance both internally and against industry competitors.

Feedback from both of these processes is invaluable in informing our management decisions and in giving our staff an external perspective on our performance.
